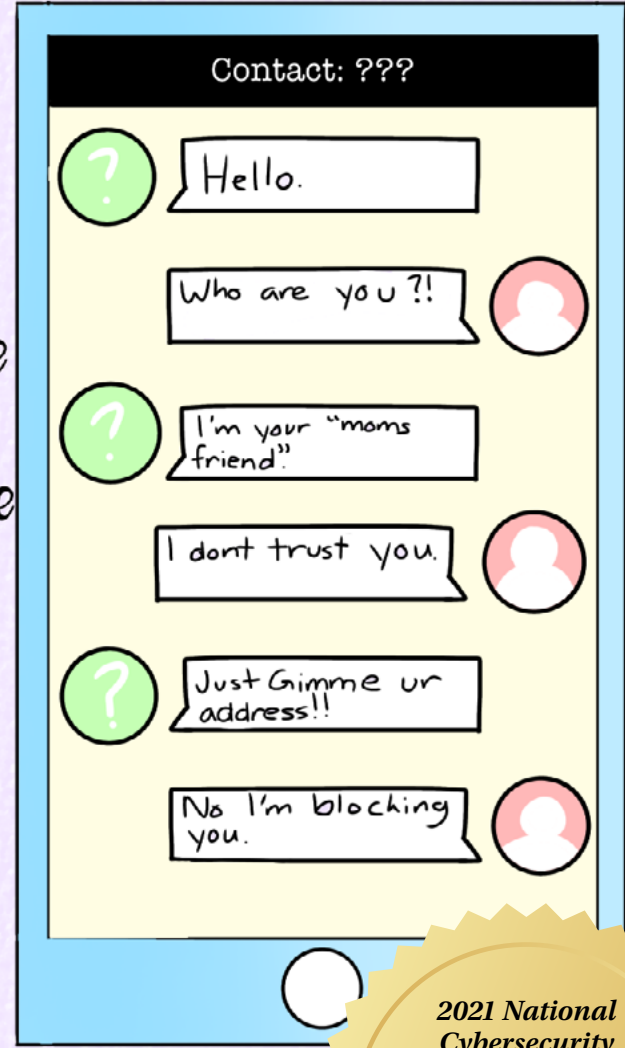

- ENSURE THAT THE SITE YOU ARE ON IS SECURE AND USES HTTPS.



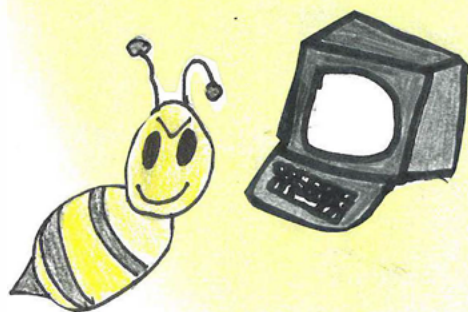

PASSWORD SAFETY

DO CREATE LONGER PASSWORDS

Try for around 16 characters. However, make sure it's not so long that you forget it.

DO CHANGE PASSWORDS ON A REGULAR BASIS

You should change your password frequently. Especially for things like banking info, this may mean every two months.

DO USE TWO-FACTOR AUTHENTICATION

If a hacker did steal your password, it's an extra layer of protection preventing unwanted access to your accounts.

DON'T USE PERSONAL INFORMATION

i.e. your name, a family member's name, pet, address, phone number, birthday. They're often publicly available and easily accessible.

DON'T REUSE PASSWORDS

If the hacker cracks just one password, they'll gain access to all your other accounts, and we don't want that.

DON'T USE REAL WORDS

Instead, try special characters like @, \$, #, or ! to increase password complexity.

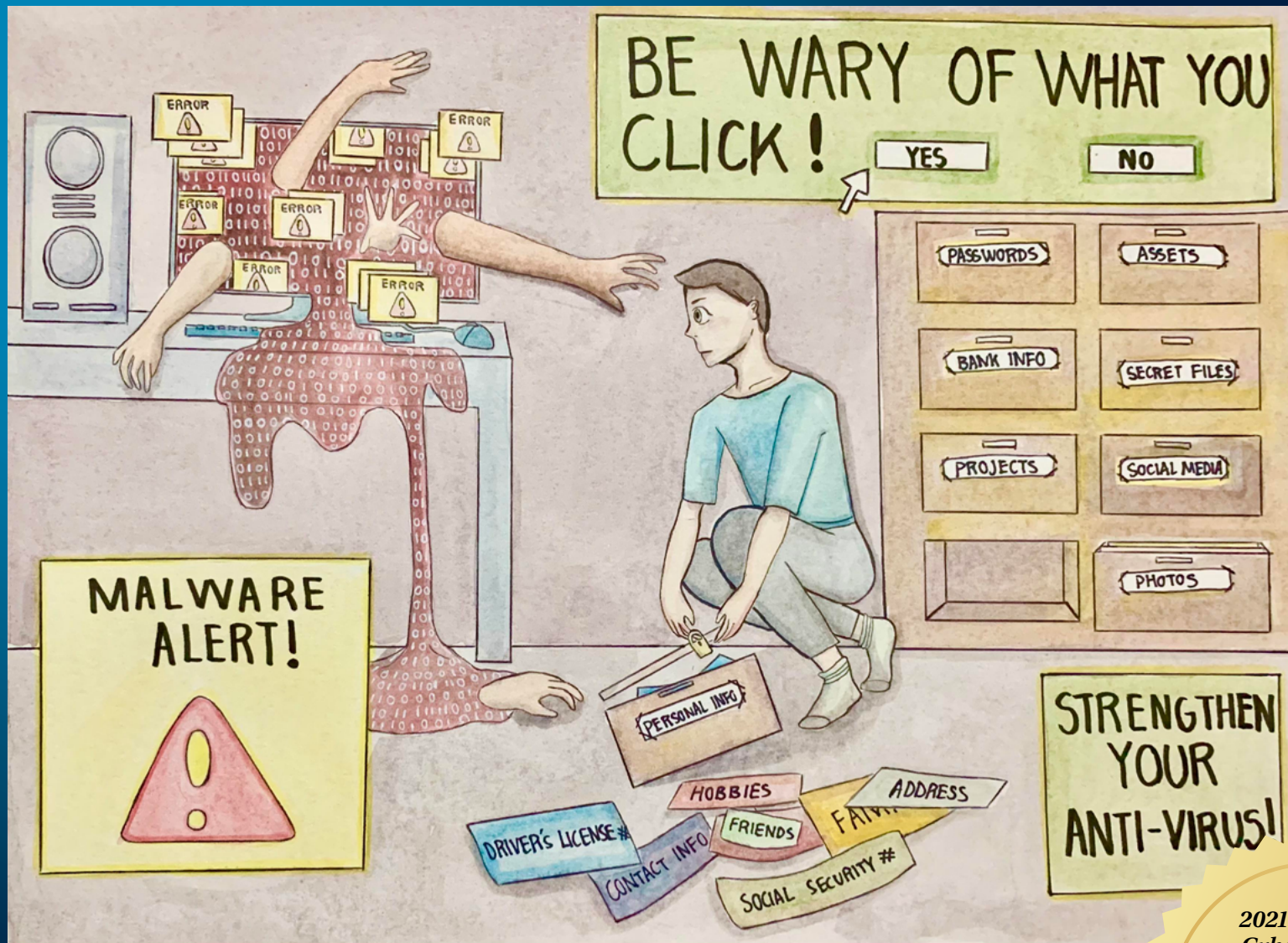

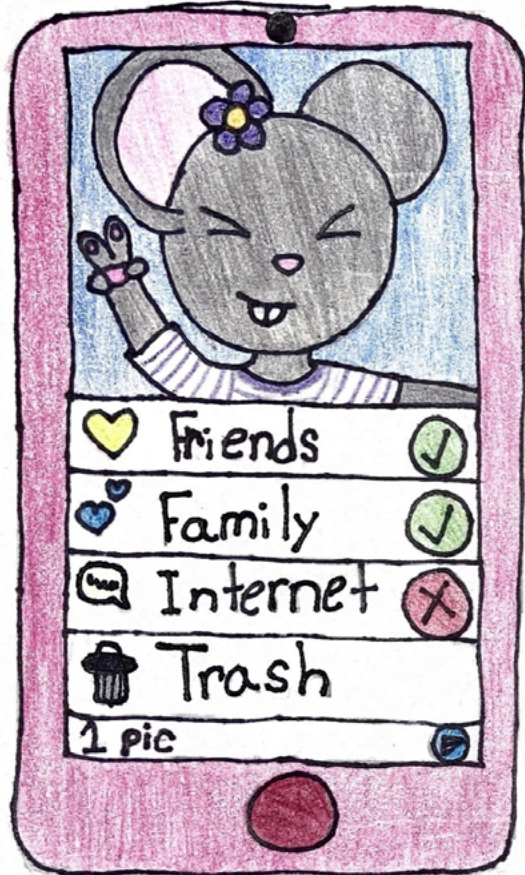
